TREES FOR GUELPH is pleased to announce the start of our 2018 Planting Program. Winter caused a delay but now we are assured that Spring will be here next Monday!

Our new project launch location and date will be Willow Road Public School, 125 Willow Road (access from Applewood off Willow) on Monday, April 23th at 11am. We will be joined by our school children planters, neighbourhood volunteers, City officials, and our supporting partners.

Our 2018 program is supported by our major partners including the City of Guelph, Copernicus Educational Products, TD Friends of the Environment Foundation, The Modern Bride, Home Depot, Guelph Hydro, Rona, Union Gas, Grand River Conservation Authority, the Upper Grand District and the Wellington Catholic District School Board. This year we expect to plant over 5,000 trees and shrubs with the help of school children and other volunteers from local communities, business and industry.
